

DEKTON CARE

Normal maintenance: due to its practically zero porosity, the ultra-compact Dekton surface is highly resistant to staining in day-to-day use and from chemical products, making it ideal for use as a kitchen worktop. In general, it is best to use a neutral soap and water.

Cleaning stubborn stains: in the case of aggressive stains, either from products that are resistant to normal cleaning agents or because they have remained on the work surface without being removed, we recommend using more specific products such as cream detergents with abrasive particles or solvents. Prevention of knocks: although Dekton is an extremely resistant surface, knocks should be avoided in areas which are more exposed (corners, edges, bevels, etc.)

Performance in contact with hot objects: frying pans, saucepans, casseroles and coffee makers, etc. can be placed directly on the work surface. Dekton is designed to withstand utensil temperatures from domestic use. However, avoid direct contact with an open flame.
